- **July 2009:** TÜV INTERCERT has been awarded by DATech with the accreditation in accordance with DIN EN 45011.
- **September 2009:** TÜV INTERCERT concluded the registration process for IECEE CB Scheme Membership (International Electrotechnical Committee for Conformity Testing): it has been accepted as NCB (National Certification Body) by IECEE-CB Scheme (IEC System for Conformity testing and Certification of Electrotechnical Equipment and Components). It has been assessed and determined to fully comply with the requirements of ISO/IEC Guide 65, The Basic Rules IECEE 01 and Rules of Procedure IECEE 02, and the relevant IECEE CB-Scheme Operational Documents. At present TÜV INTERCERT is listed as IECEE Members.
- **November 2009:** TÜV INTERCERT was reconfirmed among the foreign Certification Bodies recognized by ACCREDIA for the building sector.
- **December 2009:** TÜV INTERCERT successfully passed the yearly Audit of Surveillance as well as the Accreditation Audit for BS OHSAS 18001 and SCC (Safety checklist for contractors).
